

Texico District UPCI Camp – Child Consent Form 2019

CHILD PRINTED NAME: _____ **CONSENT AND CERTIFICATION**

I, the undersigned, being the parent/guardian of the child named above (child), do hereby consent to the participation of my child in all of the scheduled activities during the Texico District Crusaders Camp for the year 2019, and any other activities customarily associated with this camp. Further, I certify that my child is physically fit and adequately prepared to participate in all sporting events (unless otherwise noted in medical information). If my child is involved in any destructive behavior or vandalism, I understand that my child and I will be financially responsible for their actions.

MEDICAL TREATMENT AUTHORIZATION.

I understand that I will be notified in the case of a medical emergency. However, in the event that I cannot be reached, I authorize the calling of a doctor and the providing of necessary medical services in the event my child is injured or becomes ill. I authorize any one or more of the following persons to make emergency medical care decisions on behalf of my child if required by law or a health care provider. **I, (the parent)** _____, **understand the Texico District UPC will not be responsible for medical expenses incurred solely on the basis of this authorization.** I agree to notify the Camp in the event of any health changes that would restrict my child’s participation in any normal camp activities. I also understand that the adult supervisors reserve the right to restrict my child from any activity that they do not feel is within the physical capabilities of my child.

HEAD LICE POLICY.

All campers will be required to have their hair checked for head lice by the camp nursing staff before registration will be completed. If lice/nits are found, the camper will not be allowed to complete registration. The personnel in charge of the camper during camp will be asked to notify the child’s parental guardian. We ask that all church guardians stay with their youth until registration is completed. If a child is found with lice/nits after registration, the Pastor/Parent/Guardian will be contacted to a) return the camper home, b) arrange treatment (Camp staff will not provide treatment). The camper can be readmitted only if properly treated, and a letter is presented from Pastor/Parent/Guardian/Physician stating the same and the camper must be re-checked by camp nurse to be certified lice/nit free.

REFUND POLICY Due to the cost of supplies purchased in advance and workers hired, all registrations are non-refundable.

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Rules

1. There will be no physical contact between students of the opposite sex on the campground. (eg. holding hands, hugging, hitting, etc.)
2. No camper shall leave the campground without permission from the District Youth President.
3. Any camper who has a car on the campground must leave it parked in a designated area, and turn in keys for the duration of camp.
4. No camper will be permitted to return to the dorm once classes or services have begun.
5. All campers must remain in class or the Tabernacle, until dismissed.
6. NO electronic devices such as CD players, MP3 players, radios, or video games (Game Boys, Nintendo, etc.) will be permitted on the campground. If they are secretly brought and lost or stolen, no attempt will be made to locate them.
7. All lights in the dormitories must be out by the time set by the Camp Director.
8. No food or drinks are allowed in the dormitories, except for bottled water.
9. No immoral, objectionable or indecent slogans or pictures will be allowed on the campground. (This includes alcohol or tobacco advertisements).
10. No student is permitted to go behind the Tabernacle or the dorms.
11. Each morning, campers must make beds and put away their clothes before leaving the dorm. All personal items must be stored, under the bed, or hung up on hangers.
12. All cell phones must be turned off, at ALL TIMES, when in the tabernacle or dormitories.

Dress Code Girls:

1. Skirts or dresses must be worn with a hemline below the knee. No dress or skirt with a split above the knee is permitted on the campground. (On the platform, the skirt length must be at least mid-calf)
2. No pants, shorts, divided skirts, or culottes may be worn, on the campground.
3. Tops that are low-cut, see-through, or that reveal the midriff or back are not permitted. Neither sleeveless nor capped-sleeved blouses/dresses will be tolerated.
4. Tight-fitting clothing is not acceptable.
5. Make-up, necklaces, earrings, bracelets, and body piercings are not allowed, on the campground.
6. All campers and staff must be fully dressed when moving between dorms and the outside restroom facilities.

Dress Code Boys:

1. Hair must be cut above the collar and ear. No wild or outlandish hairstyles (Mohawks, man buns...etc.) will be allowed.
2. Shorts, tight-fitting or saggy pants are not allowed
3. Sleeveless shirts or shirts that reveal the back or midriff are not allowed.
4. Tight-fitting clothing is not acceptable.
5. Necklaces, earrings, bracelets, and body piercings are not allowed on the campground.
6. All campers and staff must be fully dressed when moving between dorms and outside restroom facilities. I have read and agree to abide by each rule and guideline
